 **The Problem**

Legal and procurement leaders waste time searching across repositories and escalating routine questions. Delays extend deal cycle time, increase compliance exposure, and consume high-cost SME time.

Executive summary

A governed contract intelligence solution that answers contract questions with citations and generates compliant first drafts from approved templates. It is designed to improve decision speed while preserving access controls, auditability, and human approval for higher-risk outputs.

Best-fit situations

- Best when legal/procurement teams are a bottleneck on deal velocity or post-signature clarity.
- Works against existing SharePoint/ECM contract repositories; no rip-and-replace content migration is required.
- Supports MSA, SOW, PA, EULA, amendment, and renewal scenarios with role-based access.

How it works

- Teams, web, or [Microsoft 365 Copilot](#) can serve as the user interface.
- Copilot Studio manages Entra authentication, routing, and guardrails; Foundry supports grounded Q&A; and drafting workflows.
- Azure AI Search provides hybrid retrieval and citations; metadata and relationships can be modeled in a contract knowledge layer.
- [Purview/DLP](#), Key Vault, private endpoints, and audit logging provide enterprise controls.

Implementation approach

- Align personas, repositories, templates, and success metrics.
- Connect sources and stand up secure indexing and metadata normalization.
- Enable grounded Q&A; and validate citation quality on representative contracts.
- Add compliant drafting, deviation handling, approvals, and pilot rollout.

Value and measurement

- Key outcomes: faster decision velocity, shorter drafting cycles, lower compliance exposure, and better legal SME leverage.
- Measure with time-to-answer, time-to-first-draft, approval turnaround, deviation rate, SME deflection, and grounding/citation quality.

Operating model and next step

Post-go-live, Managed AgentOps should cover evaluation sets, access reviews, prompt/template versioning, and periodic value reviews so the system stays accurate as contracts and standards change.
Recommended next step: a 45-minute readiness workshop to confirm source systems, template standards, approval boundaries, and pilot use cases.
